



Trends and Highlights


- In 2010, the national volunteer rate was 26.3 percent, with 62.8 million volunteers donating approximately 8.1 billion hours of service.
- Over the last four years, the retention rate for volunteers in New York was 55.2 percent. On a national scale, the retention rate was 64.5 percent during this time period.
- On an annual average, volunteers in New York contributed 22 service hours per resident (based on 2008-2010 data).

Volunteer Hours Per Resident





Percent


